OFFICIAL ULTIMATE FANTASY WRESTLING CHALLENGE LIVE EVENT RULES:

ROSTER SELECTION:

- **Bidding is electronic through the fantasygrade.com website**
- **Each roster must have exactly 1 wrestler per weight class.**
- **Each roster must not exceed the 1000 point salary cap.**
- **There is no salary cap minimum.**
- Weight class 1 will be randomly drawn by the website (20 seconds)
- A wrestler seeded from 1 to 16 in the chosen weight class will be randomly drawn by the website. (10 seconds)
- There will be a blind bid for each of the 33 teams to bid on that seed (15 seconds)
- If there is a bidding tie the winning bid will be the earliest bid
- This process is repeated until the top 16 seeds are completed.
- Unseeded wrestlers (17-33) to be chosen automatically by the website for the teams who did not win a bid for a seeded wrestler
- There will be a 15 minute intermission after the 3rd and 7th weight classes
- Each team **MUST** turn in their own team score prediction, the team champion prediction, and the winning team point total prediction for tiebreaker purposes.
- If a team fails to do so and ends up in a tie for first place, they will lose if the first two tiebreakers do not determine a winner. Once the auction ends, all lineups are final.
- If a wrestler withdraws from the tournament prior to the start and he is on your roster, you will receive zero points for that weight class.

TIEBREAKERS in case multiple teams score the same number of team points.

- The team with the most individual champions wins.
- The team with the most All Americans/Top 8 finishers wins.
- The team that predicts their own final team score the most accurately wins.
- The team that chooses the highest place team champion wins.
- The team that chooses the closest team champion points to the actual team champion points wins.

SCORING:

Scoring for each wrestler is based on the official wrestling tournament team scoring rules.

- 1st place 16 points
- 2nd place 12 points
- 3rd place 10 points
- 4th place 9 points
- 5th place 7 points
- 6th place 6 points
- 7th place 4 points
- 8th place 3 points

ADVANCEMENT POINTS:

- Championship bracket advancement is 1.0 points/round
- Consolation bracket advancement is 0.5 points/round
- If a wrestler has a bye and wins his next match, he earns 1 advancement point for the bye
- If a wrestler has a bye and loses his next match, he earns 0 advancement points for the bye
- Each wrestler not in a pigtail match in either the championship bracket or the consolation bracket is considered to have received a bye because of the pigtail match
- If a wrestler wins his first match, he earns 2 advancement points because of the bye
- If the losing wrestler in the championship bracket pigtail match wins his consolation match, he earns an additional 0.5 points for the bye
- The bye is NOT shown in the brackets due to space constraints

BONUS POINTS

- 2.0 points: Fall, Forfeit, Default, Disqualification
- 1.5 points: Technical Fall with backpoints
- 1.0 points: Technical Fall without backpoints, Major Decision

DEDUCTION POINTS

- If a wrestler is deducted team point(s) in the team scoring he will be deducted the same points in the contest.
- If a coach is deducted a team point, that team point is assigned to the wrestler competing for that coach when the deduction occurred.
